Activity Aim: To become a museum curator.
What would you put in your very own museum?
Lots of pictures or big statues of your favourite things - it's up to you!

You will need: Objects to make museum, craft items, paper and pens.

1. Museums are great because they teach us about history by letting us see it up close and personal. List all the different types of museums there are. Which are your favourite and why?
2. Now, it's time to curate your own museum. It could be about anything from food to guiding history, or even about your childhood. Think about how you can split your objects into themes.
3. Next, think about how you are going to present your objects:

- Text
- Pictures and diagrams
- Sound and videos
- Interactive games
- Live interpretation - where someone explains or uses the object in front of visitors.



The best museums have a mix of every style so there's something for everyone.

4. Once you have created your marvellous museum, now show it off. You can do this by recording it or take photos and posting them to the Girlguiding Kent East County Facebook page.
5. If you can why don't you have visitors (household members) or you could do a virtual call with family and/or friends. Don't forget to put your best tour guide voice on!
